Bookings are essential for this program as places are limited. Application forms and payment must be received by the due date in order to secure your child's place. If a late registration is accepted a \$20.00 fee will be charged.

It is important to note that fees for all services are payable for all booked care whether the child attends or not.

EXCURSIONS: Due to event times, the bus cannot wait for any late arrivals, so it is important that you know departure times and ensure you arrive 15 minutes prior so that the roll can be accurately taken.

When going on excursions, all children are to bring a suitable bag .i.e. backpack to carry their lunch and drink bottles (plastic bags are not appropriate). Children must wear suitable clothing and footwear.

While on the Excursion all children will wear an identification band indicating the centre's name and contact numbers.

FOOD: Children are required to bring their own packed lunch, morning and afternoon tea and a re-fillable drink bottle. In accordance with our Healthy Eating Policy. Foods such as chips, donuts, chocolates and lollies will not be permitted. Healthy food choices are strongly encouraged.

Cold drinking water is always available and a fresh fruit/vegetable platter will be served to accompany their own afternoon tea.









Please note: Food cannot be kept in the refrigerator or re-heated.

TECHNOLOGY: Children are **NOT** permitted to bring along their tablets, Nintendo DS, IPODS, IPHONES and IPADS etc.
